We are offering a Company-Sponsored Master's degree in apprenticeship with a major French International Dairy Production Company

Successful candidates will

- spend two years in France with an additional 4 months of intensive French prior to the program depending on their current level of French
- receive high level training in technical and managerial competencies and learn a new language (French)
- have all expenses costs (travel, tuition, insurance) covered
- study half time at ESA and work half time in the company with a tutor.
- successful graduates earn a Master of Science in Engineering from Ecole Supérieure d'Agricultures Angers Loire (ESA)
- work for a minimum of two and a half years for the sponsoring company in Brazil after the program in France.

The program is managed by ESA, a major institution of higher education in the field of Life Sciences in France.

Successful completion of the program earns an entry-level management position in the sponsoring company's industrial site in Brazil after the end of the program.

Requirements:

Candidates must have:

- a minimum of **four years** of Higher Education (completed and graduated) in **Animal Sciences**, **Agronomy**, **Food production**
- a strong motivation for a career in industry and especially in Food production
- a desire to learn new cultures and a new language (French)
- a real capacity to overcome challenges and to develop new competencies
- an experience abroad would be appreciated
- PLEASE NOTE: NO FRENCH REQUIRED TO APPLY

You must be under 26 on September 1st 2018 to apply.

The selection process is in two steps. ESA will examine your application and will contact you for a first interview in English by one of their team. If ESA decides you are a solid candidate we will pass your file on to the company.

ESA will arrange company interviews in Brazil in February or March 2018. The company makes the final choice. The program begins in early April 2018 for those who need French lessons and late August 2018 for French speakers.
