



MANUSCRIPT TYPES ACCORDING TO THE JOURNAL SCIENTIA AGRICOLA

POINT OF VIEW

Point of view may address virtually any critical topic in Agricultural Engineering, Agricultural Microbiology, Agrometeorology, Animal Science and Pastures, Biometry, Modeling and Statistics, Crop Science, Ecology, Entomology, Food Science and Technology, Forestry Science, Genetics and Plant Breeding, Plant Pathology, Plant Physiology and Biochemistry, Soils and Plant Nutrition and Zoology. Point of view should be well academic, well focused, and presented. They should not include data that have not been previously published.

Point of view must have no more than three authors. The first author should have sufficient expertise and experience with the topic to provide an authoritative opinion. Maximum length: up to 2000 words of text, or 1500 words with a tiny table or figure, no more than five references, which should be as current as possible. Point of view not meeting these guidelines will not be considered.
